FOLLOW THE RULES


When I am at Science World, I need to follow some rules:


- Stay with my parent or guardian the entire time

Here I will shoot water targets, run on the energy wheel, and try lots of other fun activities to learn about the environment! There might be lots of people and it might get crowded, but that's okay!








PUZZLES AND ILLUSIONS







PETER BROWN FAMILY CENTER STAGE






PETER BROWN FAMILY CENTER STAGE






BODYWORKS






EUREKA!






OMNIMAX® THEATRE






SCIENCE STORE
